## Equine Skills Courses

### Motueka High School Introductory Course

6 hours (2 x 3hrs)

Come and enjoy our New Zealand horses and learn new skills in our wonderful environment. This course is compulsory if you wish to continue with our Equine Skills 30 hour course.

#### Content

Students will be introduced to New Zealand horses, their management and environment. This introductory course will serve as an assessment for the Equine Skills 30 hour course.

#### Equipment

Students are required to have their own riding boots with smooth sole and a heel. It is recommended to have your own riding helmet of NZ safety standard. Wet/hot/cold weather clothing suitable for working outside with horses.

#### Dates and Times

This course will be offered in Term 1 (March) and Term 3 (August), 2x3 hours, days and times to be confirmed once students are enrolled. Minimum of 4 students.

# Motueka High School Foundation Course

30 hours (10 x 3 hours)

### Entry Requirements

Successful completion of the Equine Introductory Course (6 hrs).

### Content

This course has a practical approach. Work will mainly be with the horses but also include some theory assignments.

The course is designed to develop the student's knowledge and understanding of horse welfare, care and handling. The basics of riding will be included.

Students will learn about the nature and lifestyle of horses kept at grass, and preparing horse for riding and lungeing. They will be supported to achieve their equestrian goals. A certificate will be awarded on completion.

A full program will be developed with the coach once students are enrolled.

### Times and Dates

This course will start in Term 1 and Term 3 after the Introductory Course.

It will run in 10 three hour sessions, dates & times will be confirmed once enrolments are closed. Minimum of 4 students.

# Motueka High School Development Course

30 hours (10 x 3 hours)

### Entry Requirements

Successful completion of the Equine Introductory Course (6 hrs).

### Content

This course has a practical approach. Work will mainly be with the horses but also include some theory assignments.

The course is designed to develop the student's knowledge and understanding of riding, the horse, its handling and training.

Students will work on the equestrian "Scales of Training" - how to improve dressage and jumping techniques and to enjoy the New Zealand equestrian experience. Students will get the opportunity to study the horse in a holistic way.

There will be the chance for a study tour and discussions on special fields of interests. Students will be supported to achieve their equestrian goals. A certificate will be awarded on completion.

A full program will be developed with the coach once students are enrolled.
