UNIFORM – 2016

Uniforms may be purchased from Whitwells Menswear or secondhand items from the MHS Clothing Mart (Open Wed 1.30-2.30pm)

COMPULSORY

Shirt	Plain white cotton blouse with a straight hem. (Short sleeve or long sleeve).	Black/Gold regulation MHS polo shirt
Skirt or Shorts	Grey, checked and pleated skirt to be worn knee length .	Charcoal-grey regulation school shorts.
Socks/Tights	Plain white ankle socks (no emblems) visible above the shoe OR Black tights (plain).	Grey with black and gold tops worn to under the knee (ie pulled up).
Shoes	Approved Mary Jane black polishable leather or leather-like shoes. Socks or tights must be worn with the shoes (see above).	Approved traditional black polishable lace-up leather or leather-like shoes. (must have a formed heel). Socks must be worn with the shoes (see above).

OPTIONAL

Jacket 1	Black monogrammed and available through the school office or the clothing mart	
Jacket 2	Black monogrammed soft-shell zip up jacket available at Whitwells Menswear or the clothing mart.	
Blazer	Regulation black blazer, monogrammed on pocket with school crest.	
Jersey	Black, v-neck, monogrammed	
Trousers	Charcoal-grey, regulation long trousers.	
Sandals	Approved school sandals. Not to be worn with socks.	
Vest	Black v-necked, monogrammed	
Scarf	Plain black.	
Thermal	Plain white long-sleeved -worn with white blouse Plain black long sleeved -worn with black polo	
Hats	Plain black monogrammed MHS cap. OR Plain black MHS monogrammed bucket hat. OR Plain black MHS monogrammed beanies. Hats are not to be worn in class and students are strongly advised to wear them outside.	

PHYSICAL EDUCATION – PE

All students must change into suitable PE clothing. No skirts, dresses or denim is permitted
Year 9,10 – a MHS sports shirt and black shorts or long activewear pants, sports shoes and socks
Year 11,12,13 – A change of shirt, shorts. Sports shoes and socks. School shoes are not allowed in the Gym.

SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE UNIFORM

Option 1	Regulation Charcoal grey trousers (not black); white, good quality shirt, able to be buttoned at neck for tie; gold and black striped school tie; regulation black blazer, monogrammed on pocket with school crest; black polishable lace up shoes, grey socks.	
Option 2	Regulation knee-length skirt, plain black tights, Mary-Jane style black polishable shoes. (lace up shoes NOT to be worn with this option). Regulation black blazer, monogrammed on pocket with school crest, white, good quality shirt, able to be buttoned at neck for tie, gold and black striped school tie,	
Vest	Black, v-neck, monogrammed (optional)	

YEAR 13 STUDENTS

Year 13 students may wear uniform or mufti. Footwear must be suitable and clothing must meet the Y13 Dress Code.

GENERAL APPEARANCE INFORMATION FOR ALL STUDENTS

1. No facial hair or excessive makeup is permitted.	2. No jewellery other than a watch or medic alert bracelet.
3. All students are required to wear full school uniform until the end of Year 12.	4. No visible piercings other than one small sleeper or one small flush earring in each ear.
5. If taonga or a cross is worn it should be worn inside clothing and not be visible.	6. Tattoos should be kept covered
7. Students can wear alternative black jackets to and from school but once they are on school grounds, they must remove the alternative jacket and wear the correct school uniform options available.
